



## Advanced river nymphing course for grayling

Master the modern nymphing methods for grayling fishing. This course will take you through tightline nymphing, indicator fishing and the duo method. The course also includes 2hrs hours of fly tying, constructing tungsten beaded jig flies, weighted shrimps and caddis flies. After the fly tying, we'll look at tackle set up, tapered leaders, tippet, indicators, fly size and fly weigh.

We'll be out on the river for the afternoon on the first day concentrating first on how to read the water to find grayling and the setup we are going to use. Although tightline nymphing doesn't involve casting a fly line and the technique used looks easy, there's a bit more to it than meets the eye, we'll cover all the subtleties of how to effectively fish the water in front of you.

The courses will take place on our Tamar, Lyd and Thrushel beats, which range from medium/large rivers to small pocket water giving a good variety to swap to and from different methods. Chest waders are the best option, studded soles are helpful as the bed rock on our rivers can be really slippery. We have a fully stocked tackle shop onsite which also has a large range of wader and tackle hire should you need more appropriate kit (please let us know in advance if tackle and waders are required).

This course is for up to a maximum of 3 people. It is suitable for beginners but is primarily aimed at improvers.
